Or bring your lawn chair and head down to the river in Savannah for the annual Bluegrass Festival Friday, July 2 and Saturday, July 3 at Wayne Jerrold's Park.

Saturday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> fireworks are slated for the West Tennessee Diamond Jaxx at Pringles Park, McKenzie's Freedom Festival and Selmer's City Park.
